Uncollected children ...

Yesterday we sent home a text reminding parents to please collect children promptly at home time. Unfortunately, we have quite a number of children who have to wait at Reception because an adult has not arrived on time to collect them.

For Safeguarding reasons it is very important that all children are collected on time – for too many children this has now become an unfortunate pattern. Please either arrive on time to collect your child or arrange for them to attend our After School Club where supervision is provided.

To help parents who can not collect children at home time we offer a 2.00 – 3.00 pm and 3.00 – 4.00 pm Club, please ring the school Office if you will be late and arrange for your child to go to this Club, thank you.
