Rights Respecting Schools Award (RRSA)

This year in school we are embarking on the journey to become a **Rights Respecting School.** This initiative is based on the **United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.**

The award is based on principles of equality, dignity, respect, non-discrimination and participation. The initiative started in 2006 and schools involved in the Award have reported a positive impact on relationships and well-being, leading to better learning and behaviour, improved academic standards and less bullying.

The **UN Convention on the Rights of the Child contains 45 Articles** ranging from the Right to an Education, the Right to be kept safe and the Right to Relax and Play.
