Each year at this time, pupils, staff and friends of Ashgrove Primary make a huge effort to support a nominated charity. This year the charity **ACTION CANCER** will benefit from our generosity.

Action Cancer is a local charity that aims to save lives and support people affected by cancer. (All money raised stays in Northern Ireland). As well as providing breast screening, support and therapy to both adults and children, Action Cancer has a schools health promotion programme aimed at encouraging young people to make positive lifestyle choices.

Next week, a representative from Action Cancer will speak to the children about the charity and the need to raise funds. Pupils will be asked to be 'Healthy Action Heroes' as we approach Harvest.

This will involve -

- Making healthy eating choices at home and in school throughout October.
- Taking part in our Healthy Action Day in school including aerobic activities and a 'power-walk' around our new drive-in area.
