# Sports Day-Friday 9th June

Sports Day is due to take place on **Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June (weather permitting)** we are hopeful for some pleasant weather! The teachers organising Sports Day have sent home today key information for parents. However, you may find the following points a useful summary...

- Foundation Stage Sports Day (P1&2) will begin at 9.15am. After Foundation Stage Sports Day parents may take their child home if they wish, otherwise P1&2 children should be collected at 1.15pm. PLESAE COLLECT YOUR CHILD FROM THE CLASSROOM WHERE THEIR TEACHER WILL HAND THEM OVER SAFELY!
- Key Stage 1 Sports Day (P3&4) will begin at 11.15am. After Key Stage 1 Sports Day parents may take their child home if they wish, otherwise P3&4 children should be collected at 1.15pm. PLESAE COLLECT YOUR CHILD FROM THE CLASSROOMWHERE THEIR TEACHER WILL HAND THEM OVER SAFELY!
- <u>Key Stage 2 Sports Day (P5-7)</u> will begin at 1.30pm. We expect KS2 Sports Day to finish at 2.45pm. Please collect your child from their classroom where the teacher will hand them over safely.

Parents are advised that NO adults other than members of staff should instruct or supervise children during Sports Day- this is due to our Child Protection guidelines.

We hope you can come along and enjoy the day in a safe and structured environment.

If for any reason we need to postpone Sports Day we will endeavor to give you as much notice as possible. If this happens we will send a notification via text message to your nominated first preference on our school records. Please also refer to our website, Facebook page & twitter before ringing the school.
