16 HABITS OF MIND – QUESTIONING & PROBLEM POSING

In Ashgrove we are working with our children to develop 16 Habits of Mind... these are a set of skills and dispositions which research has shown are key qualities in effective learning and life long development. In school we have already looked at Persisting, Striving for Accuracy, Thinking & Communicating with Clarity & Precision and Managing Impulsivity.

Pupils may have brought home certificates to congratulate them on demonstrating these qualities.

This Half Term in school we have looked at Questioning & Problem Posing. We have encourage our pupils to ask really good questions about what they are learning and pose problems to investigate... This Habit of Mind also develops the following qualities:

- Pride in their work;
- Taking time to check over;
- Focus;
- Accomplishing a task;
- Correcting mistakes or inaccuracies
