Which leaves us with the final event before we go off on our mid-term break, the HALLOWEEN DISCO! Please note the following guidelines for the event below:

- On the evening of the disco, all pupils should arrive through the P1/4 entrance door and leave via the P3/5 gates. **P1-P4 parents need to pick their children up at 5.00 p.m. at the P3/P5 gates and P5-P7 parents at 6.00 p.m.**
- Entrance costs £5.00 per pupil which includes a drink, sweets and snack. Any dietary requirements have been taken into account and these children will receive a wristband on entry. They will need to keep these on for the duration of the disco. There will be face painting available during the event - any children who have allergies or skin conditions will need to notify our PTFA team on arrival, so that we are aware of these children.
- As the children leave via the P3/P5 gates, parents will be able to take pictures of their children using a variety of selfie frames, masks and props. Please be aware, for child protection reasons, we ask that you refrain from taking pictures of other children, unless you have received permission from their parents.
- For supervision reasons, children should not wear facemasks to the Disco
- Any children attending an after-school club can bring in a change of clothing.
- The event will be supervised by members of the PTFA, therefore parents/carers are not required to attend.
- As the evenings are dark, pupils will not be permitted to walk home unaccompanied.
